MEMORANDUM FOR COMPETING UNITS

2 May 2012

SUBJECT: Air Force JROTC Championship Military Skills Meet

1. You are cordially invited to attend the Air Force JROTC Championship Military Skills Competition on 20 Oct 2012, Saturday, at Arlington High School. Based on the response of our poll, this will be the State Air Force Junior ROTC Championship. In addition to the overall meet championship, an AFJROTC State Championship trophy will be awarded to the Air Force unit that receives the most points in the events marked (\*).

2. Events scheduled for this year are as follows:

- Academic Team\*
- Regulation Armed Drill\*
- Exhibition Armed Drill \*
- Regulation Unarmed Drill\*
- Exhibition Unarmed Drill\*
- Saber/Sword Team Regulation Drill
- Color Guard\*
- Physical Fitness\*
- Inspection\*
- Drill Down

**TROPHIES GIVEN FOR FIRST THROUGH THIRD PLACES IN EACH EVENT.**

(\* =Must compete in these for Air Force JROTC Championship points)

3. Waivers must be completed for every cadet competing, regardless of their event. Fees are:

\$25.00 per Academic Team (one only)

\$25.00 per Saber/Sword Team (one only)

\$25.00 per armed drill team (one only)

\$25.00 per unarmed drill team (one only)

\$25.00 per color guard team (two only)

\$25.00 per athletic team ( max of one male team and one female team of four cadets each)

\$15.00 Inspection (Must have ten cadets minimum in a service uniform, no BDUs, Fatigues, or Unique Drill Team uniforms)

Drill Down is free to participants only. Must be in a uniform (PTs is a uniform)

4. All events are co-ed, except PT. All drill teams must have a minimum of seven members (including the team CO) They must compete in regulation drill (armed or unarmed), using current service regulations. Exhibition drill is optional, except for the Air Force teams competing for the State Championship trophy. All armed categories, including sabre/sword, will be in accordance with Army FM 22-.5(or Navy Landing Party Manual if applicable) Color Guards will consist of four members only.
5. Drill Down will be in accordance with Air Force Instruction 36-2203. Please send entry form and fees NLT 1 Oct 2011. No refunds can be given after that date. Make out checks to Arlington High School AFJROTC.
6. There are no boundary line or time violations. Once you have completed the regulation portion of drill, go immediately into the exhibition portion (if competing). If a drill pad is not being used and the judges are ready, you may go ahead of your scheduled time, but not after. You will be scratched if you are fifteen minutes late. You may check with Lt Col Kelly, before the event, to change your reporting time. Schools that need to use the same cadets for several events may have to wait until they are finished. This must be worked out before the fifteen minute time limit. Lt Col Kelly is the Head Judge and will break all ties and resolve all technical problems.
7. Let me know if you cannot stay for the award ceremony and I will arrange to have your trophies delivered to you.
