This training session will provide parents with ways to structure play and leisure activities in the home to increase their child's independence.

Participants will focus on strategies that enable children with autism and other behavioral challenges to demonstrate self-control and organizational skills. Participants will have the opportunity to develop individual schedules, communication systems, work systems, and behavioral reminders. Each parent may attend alone, but is encouraged to attend with an educator such as an in-home trainer or teacher (both must register). School personnel must attend with a parent. Fee covers cost of instructional materials.
