## About the CTC

- The future CTC will be located on the current site of Hutcheson Junior High. The junior high will be torn down and its students will consolidate with Workman Junior High.
- High school juniors and seniors will remain enrolled in their home campuses and attend CT courses at the Center.
- Current high school CT spaces are full, prohibiting expansion or new classes. The CTC will relieve overcrowding at high schools and allow the district to offer new programs and opportunities. The new building will also allow a greater number of students to take CT classes than are currently able.
- The CTC will be able to accommodate 4,800 students every two days.
- The CTC building will be flexible, allowing spaces to be easily transformed depending on programming needs.
- The clustering of CT programs in one building will allow for many cross-curricular opportunities.
- The CTC will host the AISD's data center.
