**SPECIFICATIONS**

Arlington Independent School District proposes to establish an annual contract for Musical Instrument Repair & Service. Since a service and/or repair contract cannot be solely based on price, the District also will consider vendor history & past performance as criteria for award of the contract. This will be a multiple-award bid.

**GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS**

Any repairs that may run in excess of \$200.00 must be reported to the Director of Fine Arts before any work is begun.

**PART I - WOODWIND INSTRUMENTS**

1. **Normal adjustment to restore to playing condition** - Replacement of necessary key cork & pads, straightening bent keys, recovering lost motion, closing all leaks & key wedging done on request only, or with approved quote on an instrument-by-instrument basis. Instruments must be leak light & play tested.
2. **Repads** - All instruments are completely dismantled; keys & body parts are cleaned; key tenon & necks are recorked as necessary; all screws & rods are oiled. Instruments are reassembled after all new pads have been installed; repads include complete adjustment & testing.
3. **Overhauls** - Silver replating of keys or instrument body is to be done on request only, or with approved quote on an instrument-by-instrument basis & is not part of this bid.
4. **Flutes-Piccolos** - All instruments are completely dismantled; keys & body parts are cleaned & all dents removed; body & keys are polished; springs, corks & pads are replaced; action is repaired as necessary; keys are wedged to recover post motion. Instrument is reassembled, adjusted & leak light & play tested.
5. **Clarinets/Oboes/Bassoons/Etc.** - All instruments are completely dismantled; keys & body parts are cleaned; body & posts are polished; springs, corks & pads are replaced; action is repaired as necessary; keys are wedged to recover lost motion; instrument is reassembled, wood is oil-treated, adjusted & tested. Crack work done on request only, or with approved quote on an instrument-by-instrument basis & is not part of this bid. Adjust bocal to ensure proper seal at wing joint.
6. **Saxophones** - All instruments are completely dismantled; keys & body parts are cleaned, polished & lacquered, all dents are removed; springs, corks & pads are replaced, action is repaired as necessary; keys are wedged to recover lost motion; instrument is reassembled, adjusted & leak light & play tested.

**PART II - BRASS INSTRUMENTS**

1. **Normal adjustment to restore to playing condition** - Replacement of key corks, valve stem felts & corks, pull & lube slides & pistons; resolder loose connections. Dent work done on request only or with approved quote on an instrument-by-instrument basis. Mouthpiece shanks are straightened. Re-align all turning & valve slides to maintain proper air seal. Polish pistons on rotors & oil.
2. **Chemical clean for brass lacquered & silver plated instruments** - All instruments are completely dismantled; all tubing & mouthpieces are chemically cleaned; valves or rotors are cleaned, oiled & adjusted with new cork washers & felts, or bumpers installed; water key corks are replaced, all turning slides are greased; instrument is completely reassembled & tested; rotary valves are restrung. All tuning & valve slides are re-aligned. Lacquer is burred & polished to maintain consistent finish.
3. **Clean & Silver** - Same as Item 2 chemical clean but includes complete polishing.
4. **Overhauls** - All instruments are completely dismantled; old lacquer is removed & all parts are chemically cleaned; all dents are removed; instrument is polished & lacquered; slides are realigned; valves or rotors are cleaned, oiled & adjusted with new cork washers & felts, or bumpers installed; water key corks are replaced; rotors are restrung, all turning slides are greased; instrument is reassembled & tested. Replacement of major parts (bells, mouth pipes, valves, slides or fitting or replating of valves to be done only with approved quote on an instrument-by-instrument basis & are not a part of this bid.

## CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Effective January 1, 2006, Chapter 176 of the Local Government Code requires a person who contracts or seeks to contract with the Arlington Independent School District for the sale or purchase of property, goods, or services to file a conflict of interest questionnaire with the District. The questionnaire must be filed no later than the seventh business day after the date that the person: (1) begins contract discussions or negotiations with the District or (2) submits to the District a response to a request for proposal or bid, correspondence, or another writing related to a potential agreement with the District.

An updated conflict of interest questionnaire must be filed no later than September 1 of each year in which the person: (1) has begun contract discussions or negotiations with the District or (2) submits to the District an application, response to a request for proposals or bids, correspondence or another writing related to a potential agreement with the District; and (3) the seventh business day after the date on an event that would make a statement in the questionnaire incomplete or inaccurate. The updated questionnaire is not required if the person has filed an updated questionnaire on or after June 1, but before September 1 of that year.

It is the vendor's responsibility to interpret the requirements of Chapter 176 of the Local Government Code.
