The 77th Legislature directed school districts to establish local school health advisory councils to assist in assuring that local community values and health issues are reflected in the districts' curriculum. During the 77th legislative session, the bill also allowed school districts to include a coordinated health education program designed to prevent obesity, cardiovascular disease, and type 2 diabetes through coordination of health education, physical education, nutritional services, parental involvement and instruction to prevent the use of tobacco.
