PURPOSE

The primary purpose of summer school is to offer the student an opportunity to strengthen any weakness that may exist and to make up subjects failed. All phases of summer school work comply with Texas Education Agency regulations. The courses and programs meet the same standards as the regular term. Recognizing the particular need for some students to graduate at an earlier date, summer school will offer some senior level courses. However, it is strongly recommended that these courses be taken during the regular school year to provide a more complete curriculum with depth and enrichment.

REGISTRATION/CALENDAR

Students are required to bring their **course approval form** signed by their school counselor or principal and by the parent or guardian to Summer School Registration. **Full payment of tuition is due at registration.** Pre-registration date(s) in May will be announced at each high school campus.

TUITION

Tuition will be **\$140 per semester credit** **Full payment of tuition is due at registration.** Refunds will be issued only for courses not making. No out-of-district students will be enrolled. **Student must be living with parent in Arlington.**

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

Summer school is a highly intensified program in which one day equates to almost one week in the long term. The required hours of attendance are mandated by the Texas Education Agency. Students may be withdrawn for excessive tardies or absences. Three or more excused absences each semester is considered excessive. One unexcused absence is grounds for immediate withdrawal. If a student is withdrawn, an appeal may be made to a building attendance review committee, which consists of the principal and designated building personnel. During the summer students may become aware of opportunities to attend activities which may include college visits, student council camp, and band, choir camp, drill team or cheerleading camp. These camps allow students great opportunities to improve specific skills; however, **these absences are unexcused.** We recommend that you decide prior to enrollment the student's commitment to the summer school program. **No refund is given for students that are withdrawn for attendance reasons. Friday, July 1 is not a holiday. There will be no classes on Monday, July 4. Classes will resume Tuesday, July 5.**

STUDENT DISCIPLINE

The AISD Student Code of Conduct applies to the summer school program as well as to the regular school year. A Level III or Level IV offense will result in a student's dismissal from the summer school program. In addition, the dress code approved by the AISD will be followed. **No refund is given for students that are withdrawn for discipline reasons.**

LOCATIONS

The following campuses will be consolidated: Arlington High School students will attend classes at Martin High School and Seguin High School students will attend classes at Bowie High School. **Transportation will be provided for students from Arlington and Seguin.**
