



Using technology to integrate multiple types of media, simultaneously, to present or interact with content. This can include sound, graphics, video, text, animation, user interactivity, or any other media.

Examples: Interactive tutorials and slide show presentations

Each entry is required to comply with both General Rules and Category Rules.

Category Rules:

- The CD submitted should include all support files such as audio, video, and graphics.
- Participants must use fonts that are readily available to judges.
- Each entry must be submitted on a separate CD.

Judging Criteria:

Curriculum Connection - 30%

- The educational purpose is clearly evident.
- Completion of this project results in the student's mastery of subject-area and technology TEKS.
- Careful attention is given to writing, spelling and grammar.

Content - 20%

- Information is clear, appropriate, and correct.
- Includes at least three elements: audio, animation, graphics, video, text
- Content reflects stated purpose on introduction/opening.
- Subject knowledge is evident in the product.

Design / Layout - 20%

- Easy to read
- Logical sequence of information
- Successful navigation
- Effective use of space
- Consistent formats

Creativity and Originality - 20%

- Good use of color
- Creative/artistic use of elements
- Evidence of new thought

Credits / Works Cited - 10%

- All works are properly credited and permission is granted in writing for their use, if necessary.
- All sources properly cited
