

EXTENDED ESSAY TIMELINE: CLASS OF '08

James Bowie High School IB Program

Monday, April 2, 2008	Mrs. Phenix sends out all-call email for EE supervisors, as well as a flyer in all faculty mailboxes.
Monday, April 2	Mr. Wood introduces the EE in a brief power point and distributes the General Guides in TOK.
Week of April 9-13	Mr. Wood works with students in TOK to select a subject and topic and to set up an EE Notebook.
Tuesday, April 10 7:00am & 3:00 pm	General Information Meeting for interested faculty in room 600. Distribute General Guide & Supervisor Duties from EE Guide. Complete Supervisor Information Form.
Friday, April 13	Mrs. Phenix compiles list of EE Supervisors.
Monday, April 16	Students select their supervisor from the list.
Wednesday, April 25 3:00-5:00 pm	EE Supervisor training session in Room 600 on how to help students frame an effective research question on their topic and develop the prospectus.
April 26-May 3	EE Supervisors meet with IB student to frame research question.
Monday, May 7/8	Research questions due to Mr. Wood in TOK.
May 7-17	Time (and guidance!) given within TOK to work on Prospectus and Annotated Bibliography.
May 18-23	EE Supervisors read Prospectus and Annotated Bibliography and contact student if there are problems.
Tuesday, June 5 & Wednesday, June 6 9:00 am-1:00 pm	EXTENDED ESS-CAPADE at Bowie—two days to work on your Extended Essay with Mr. Wood, Mrs. Phenix and Ms. Thomas on hand for gentle guidance and encouragement.
Summer	Students contact their EE Supervisor as needed while researching and writing. REMEMBER: Your EE will be a fine topic of discussion in college application essays and in college admission interviews, especially if it reveals work, thought, and enthusiasm (yea, passion!) for your topic.

Full first draft of Extended Essay (submitted through turnitin.com) due, including: abstract, title page, table of contents, and works cited page.

Monday, September 10--

Supervisor reads first draft and confers with student about strengths and weaknesses of paper, following IB guidelines. Student begins work on second draft (which may be very close to the final!)

Friday, October 5

Second draft of Extended Essay (submitted through turnitin.com) due to Supervisor.

Thursday, October 18
3:00-4:00

EE Supervisor Meeting to discuss second drafts.

Friday, November 16
