



AISD Advanced Placement Fee Guidelines 2012 Testing

Students who do not qualify for fee reductions will pay \$13.

Students who qualify for fee reductions will pay the College Board AP Exam Fee, minus any state, local and College Board subsidies (\$8).

AISD will pay most of the AP Exam fee for students who meet the following criteria:

- AISD High School student who has not graduated and is enrolled in the corresponding AP course;
OR
- With Principal approval, a student who is not enrolled in the corresponding course, such as:
 1. The student is taking IB and AP exams, but is not enrolled in the corresponding AP course.
 2. The student has a strong background in the subject (i.e., native language speaker).
 3. The student is taking an AP Exam as a retest.
 4. Home-schooled high school student who has not graduated and who lives in AISD boundaries.

Without principal approval, AISD students pay the full cost of the exam, minus subsidies (\$49).

Students enrolled in private schools who wish to test in AISD pay the full cost (\$87) for the exam.

AISD AP Exam Fee Structure

- AISD will pay exam fees only. Additional fees for student grade reporting services will not be paid by the district.
- The \$40 fee for a late test administration on an alternate date will be paid by AISD if the student is competing in contests as a school representative (i.e., UIL).
- Schools may determine if the campus will pay any late test fees for other students.
- AISD pays the district portion of the AP exam fee, regardless of the student's score on the exam.

AP Exam Fees Paid to College Board

- (\$49) – Texas subsidized cost for students without financial need. The school pays \$5 of the \$13 paid by the student; the district contributes \$44.
- (\$8) – Texas subsidized cost for students with financial need. Unused Exam fee
- (\$13) – The school contributes \$13 collected from the student for each unused exam.
