



**2012 AP Exam Fees
College Board Invoice and AISD Reconciliation Form**

Fee Reductions (Student pays \$8)

College Board fee:	\$79	(School forgoes \$8 rebate.)
College Board subsidy:	- \$22	= \$57
TEA subsidy:	- \$30	= \$27
Student pays:	- \$ 8	= \$19
USDE subsidy:	- \$18	= \$ 9

Due to College Board: \$ 9 (School contributes \$8; District, \$1)

Others (Student pays \$13)

College Board fee:	\$87	
College Board rebate:	- \$ 8	= \$79
TEA subsidy:	- \$30	= \$49
School pays:	- \$ 5	= \$44
AISD pays:	- \$44	= \$ 0

Due to College Board: \$49

School retains \$8 per exam of the \$13 paid for each exam, must be used to pay administration costs of AP exams.

Others (Student pays \$49 or \$87)

School retains \$8, sends remainder (\$41 or \$ 79) to district.

Unused Exams

College Board fee:	\$13	
School pays:	\$13	= \$0

Summary:

Fee Reductions:

Schools collect \$8 from each student or pay the \$8 for the student. \$8 per exam is sent to Advanced Academics.

Unused Exams:

School sends \$13 (full amount collected) to Advanced Academics.

Private-Schooled or Testing without Principal Approval:

School retains \$8 for exam, sends balance collected (\$41 or \$79) to Advanced Academics.
