Adding a Required Course (Yellow Slots)

Step 1. Click on the plus (+) icon of an empty yellow slot.

Step 2. You will see all the courses that are offered for that subject. You can hover or click on the course name for more information about the course. You will only be able to select from the courses shown.

Step 3. When you hover or click on the course name, you will also see the pre-requisite requirements for the course. A pre-requisite requirement is a requirement that must be completed before you can select a course.

- A **BLUE** dot will appear if there is additional information you need to know about a course.

- A **RED** dot will appear if you have not completed a pre-requisite for a course.

Adding an Elective Course (White Slots)

Step 1. Click on the plus (+) icon of an empty white slot.

Step 2. Click on “Select a School Discipline” to see a list of courses offered under that discipline at AHS. Select an option to continue.

You will see all the related courses that are offered under that discipline.

You can hover or click on the course name for more information.

When you hover or click on a course name, you will also see any course notes or pre-requisite requirements for the course.

Step 3. Select a course by clicking on the plus (+) icon.

Course Planner Diplomas & Certifications
