

# Kindergarten Classroom Management Plan

In order to provide the best educational climate for your child, we have developed the following classroom management plan that will be in effect at all times.

## Rules:

1. Follow instructions.
2. Respect self and others.
3. Take care of materials.
4. Keep hands, feet and objects to self.

Each child will have a take-home folder with a discipline calendar included in it. Please review the calendar each night with your child, initial the day's square, and make sure your child returns the folder each day.

You will see a stamp or a sticker in the folder to reward good citizenship. Other rewards at school will include verbal praise or special notes and phone calls home.

We will strive to become a community of learners who respect others and ourselves. We will daily affirm that we care for each other and that our objective is to learn and to help others to learn also. Those who intentionally interfere with the rights of others, who show disrespect for others, or who break class or school rules, will experience the following consequences:

1<sup>st</sup> offense: verbal warning

2<sup>nd</sup> offense: note to family in folder (no stamp)

3<sup>rd</sup> offense: removal from activity

4<sup>th</sup> offense: phone call to family

5<sup>th</sup> offense: extreme misbehavior...send discipline referral to office

Extreme misbehavior is behavior such as hitting, fighting, or defying the teacher.
