## Consequences of a FELONY:

- Difficulty finding a job
- Difficulty obtaining housing (renting)
- Inability to hold a professional or business license
- Disqualification from running for elected office
- Loss of voting rights
- Inability to obtain Driver's license or CDL
- Ineligibility for government benefits, including nutritional assistance programs, public housing
- Loss of eligibility for certain loans, including student loans
