- 4. A completed scholarship application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 5. A double spaced typed essay of at least 500 words to address the following statement:

"Share with us about an African American that you admire and aspire to emulate his or her humanitarian contributions that were made in the state of Texas, America, or World Wide"
