GUIDELINES:

1. **FUNDS.** The Larson Elementary PTA will award **two** \$500 scholarships to **two** graduating seniors.
2. **ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS.** Applicants must have attended and completed one full academic year at Larson.
3. **QUALIFICATIONS.** This application is available to students interested in attending any college or vocational school upon graduation. The Larson PTA Scholarship Committee will consider all applicants regardless of grade point average.
4. **ESSAY.** Applicants must submit a double-spaced typed essay of at least 250 words on the following topic.

“Describe a significant experience that has occurred in your life. How did you respond and what did you learn about yourself from this experience?”
5. **RECOMMENDATION LETTER.** Applicants must submit **one** recommendation letter from a teacher, counselor, administrator or staff from the applicant’s current high school.
6. **TRANSCRIPT.** A copy of the applicant’s high school transcript through the first semester of senior year. Applications without complete transcripts are automatically rejected.
7. **DEADLINE.** The Larson Elementary PTA scholarship committee should receive all applications by May 15, 2024. The application, essay, recommendation letter and transcript should be mailed or dropped off together in an envelope to Larson elementary with the below information on the envelope.
