

How to Look Up My Child's STAAR Results in the Student Portal

1. In your web browser go to www.texasassessment.com
2. Enter the Unique Student Access Code and Student's Date of Birth and click **Log In To Student Portal** to see your child's test history.
 - The access code can be located:
 - By looking in the Parent Self Serve under the Testing Tab in the "Portal Cd" column
 - By looking on a STAAR Report Card or Confidential Student Report from a previous year's test administration
