

### Instruments and Uniforms

- \$9.8 million has been allocated for uniforms and instruments over the next five years.
- The AISD is committed to providing access to fine arts opportunities for all students.
- Eliminate instrument usage fee, so playing an instrument is free and available to all students.

# Safety and Security

### Install new security cameras and NVRs in 24 schools

- ◆ All schools will eventually receive new cameras as part of the 2014 Bond package.
- ✤ Video surveillance coverage will increase from 35 to 80% of each campus.

#### Add secure entry vestibules (part of facilities budget) at:

- ♦ Workman Junior High
- ✤ Jones Academy of Fine Arts and Dual Language
- Corey Academy of Fine Arts and Dual Language

# Technology

Develop and begin implementation of minimum tech standards for each classroom

Transformation through Innovation Grants (\$1 million each year)

 Grants for AISD teachers who develop transformational methods of teaching through technology

#### Increase access to devices for students

- Grades Pre-K-2: iPad minis
- ➡ Grades 3-12: Chromebooks

Plan new data center at future Career and Technical Center

Increase Internet bandwidth by 100%

- Increase wireless capacity
- Install new voicemail system for district
- Wire 24 schools for new security cameras
- New cameras and lenses for journalism programs at each high school

- Student tracking GPS system (Zonar) on all buses
  - ➡ Implementation begins September 2015

### 36 new buses

- ✤ 23 propane buses
  - 6 full passenger buses
  - 17 special education buses
    - (15 with wheelchair lift)
- I 3 diesel buses



### 39 service fleet vehicles

✤ Includes 5 Suburbans
