



FINE ARTS

The AISD values fine arts as an integral part of a world-class education. With nearly \$10 million in bond funds, the district will improve access to fine arts programs, remove barriers that prevent students from participating, provide instruments for students who cannot afford them and support program growth.



Fine arts bond funds will be used for:

- Instruments
- Uniforms
- Risers and choir shells

Fine arts projects contained within the facilities budget include:

- Districtwide Fine Arts Center
 - → Performance hall
 - → Classrooms (including virtual learning)
 - → Instrument repair facility
- Multi-purpose activity centers at each high school
 - → For fine arts and athletics
- Fine arts/dual language academies
 - → Jimmy and Laura Jones Academy at the current Roquemore Elementary (north Arlington)
 - → Dean P. Corey Academy at the current Corey Elementary (south Arlington)
- One strings room at each elementary school
- Upgrade of existing fine arts space at each high school
