Over \$82.5 million from the bond package is earmarked for improving safety and security and for enhancing educational technology resources.



Safety & Security

- Increase video surveillance to 80%
 - → Replace old cameras
 - → Add more cameras
 - → Transition from DVR to NVR
- Digital signage at each campus
 - → Integrated with emergency notification systems
- Bus and passenger tracking
- Wireless phones for campus administrators

Technology

- Increase technology access for students
 - → Develop and implement minimum tech standards for each classroom
 - → Access to mobile devices for students and teachers
- Improve technology infrastructure
 - → Wireless enhancements (more wireless access points)
 - → New purpose-built data center at Career and Tech Center
 - → Increase Internet bandwidth from 3 to 9 Gb
- Campus grants for innovative uses of tech in education
 - → Transformation Through Innovation
- Districtwide voicemail system
- Life-cycle equipment replacements
- Tech support for special and co-curricular programs
 - → Art, athletics, journalism, library services, special education
