

BOND 2014 UPDATE

Arlington voters approved a \$663.1 million bond in May 2014. The proceeds are helping the AISD make great strides in four areas: facilities; fine arts; safety, security and technology; and transportation.



FACILITIES

The largest portion of the bond is for building new facilities and updating and improving all existing campuses.

\$9.8 million over five years for instruments, uniforms and music capital



Since the start of the bond and elimination of instrument fees, secondary band and orchestra participation is up over 17 percent.
