# About Our Presenters

**AP Calculus-** Dixie Ross has taught AP Calculus AB and BC in Texas high schools for over 30 years and has helped train calculus teachers all over the country since 1992. She has been a reader for the AP Calculus exam, has served as an outside item writer for the exam and has served on the instructional design team.

**AP English Language-** Kevin McDonald has taught AP Lang for roughly 25 years, has been an Exam Reader, Table Leader, Sample Selector, and/or Question Leader since 2002, and is currently the High School Co-Chair of the AP English Language Curriculum and Exam Development Committee.

**AP English Literature-** Michelle Iskra has been an Austin-area AP English Literature & Composition instructor since 2004. She has simultaneously taught Composition and British and American Lit as an adjunct professor at Austin Community College since 2003. Michelle has served as an AP English Literature & Composition Exam Reader and Table Leader since 2010 and is a frequent presenter at the AP Annual Conference and other conferences and institutes.

**AP Human Geography-** Kate Beeson taught AP Human Geography, AP World History, and AP Euro for seven years before joining UWorld, where she is a content creator for AP Social Studies courses.

**AP Statistics-** Taylor Wilkerson is the Math Curriculum Manager at UWorld. He oversees the SAT, ACT, AP Statistics, and both AP Calculus question banks. Prior to UWorld, Taylor worked for 5 years as an editor and author at a math textbook company. He has astrophysics and mathematics degrees from the University of Oklahoma, and is a moderator of the 250k member SAT and 150k member ACT communities on Reddit.

**AP World History-** Christine Bond-Custred currently teaches Advanced Placement (AP) United States History and AP World History at Edmond Memorial High School, in Edmond OK. She has taught AP United States History since 1997 and AP World History since 2007. She holds a Master's degree in Education Administration and in school counseling (M.Ed.) and is a National Board Certified Teacher (NBCT). Ms. Custred has been a College Board consultant since 2000, presenting at numerous College Board institutes including international institutes. She has been an AP Summer Institute consultant since 2003, presenting at well over 50 summer institutes. She co-authored the Research and Education Association (REA) test prep book for AP United States History, she wrote the AP review questions for the AP edition of the Making America textbook, she co-authored the Fast Track to a 5 for AP World History and was a contributing author of the teacher's edition of the Ways of the World textbook. She has developed and team taught a combination course that bridges AP U. S. History and AP English Language and has co-presented at a Southwest Regional College Board conference and presented at the AP annual conference in Orlando in July, 2019. She served as an AP mentor from 2015-2017; this mentoring program, designed and offered by the College Board, entailed conducting once a month webinars with new AP United States history teachers. She is currently serving her second of three years as a member of the consultant advisory panel for the College Board. She has served as a reader for the AP World History exam and is currently a table leader at the AP United States History reading.
