



Course Requirements for Graduation

4 credits English -----

ELA I, II, III, one credit in any authorized advanced English course

4 credits Mathematics ---

Algebra I, Geometry, two credits in any authorized advanced math course

4 credits Science -----

Biology, IPC, Chemistry or Physics plus two additional advanced courses

3 credits Social Studies ---

U.S. History, U.S. Government (.5 credit), Economics (.5 credit), World History or World Geography

2 credits Foreign Language –

Must be in the same language

1 credit Physical Education

ENDORSMENTS: STEM – science, technology, engineering and math

1 credit Fine Arts

Business & Industry

7 credits in electives**

Public Services

Arts & Humanities

You will need to meet credit requirements specific to at least one endorsement

Additional Graduation Requirements

STAAR/EOC

Students must pass the following STAAR/EOC exams: Algebra I, Biology, English I, English II, US History

FAFSA

All students **MUST** submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). If not eligible to submit the FAFSA, they must submit the Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA).

This is a state graduation requirement.

Community Safety Course

All students must complete the Peace Officer Interaction course prior to graduation.

This is a state graduation requirement.

Check the Fine Print

State Attendance Policy – ABS*

*Students MUST be present 90% of the time the class meets, but no less than 75%.

*Students can contact their Assistant Principal for more information about making up hours.

Options for Making up classes


- * Credit by Exam
- * Edgenuity (credit recovery)

*Speak with the counselor to determine eligibility for credit by exam and/or Edgenuity. The counselor can advise the student/parent regarding the best means to recover credit.

Senioritis




- Side effects may include:

APPLYING TO COLLEGE

When – Verify the application deadline. Some scholarships require admission. Getting your admission status early provides access to scholarship money.

Where — After you've narrowed down your choices, visit the campus. Seniors have one day per semester to visit a college campus. This day will NOT count against their attendance, or impact exam exemptions. Take advantage of this opportunity to see if you feel comfortable on the campus.

How — If you're applying for institutions in the state of Texas use the Apply Texas application. If you're applying to institutions out of state, you can use the Common Application (XELLO). Most institutions will accept one or both of those applications.


