

Overview

- The program is 4 semesters long
 - First 3 semesters of program are Fire training
 - Junior year class meets 2nd & 3rd period. "A" days
 - After junior year Skills week / Boot camp first or second week of summer break.
 - Week long camp of live fire all week. Mon Fri 7am 7pm
 - Skills sign off
 - Skills Demo / Family night the last Friday of the week
 - After junior year Ride outs with AFD
 - Minimum grade requirement of 75
 - No major discipline infractions



Overview

- Senior year class meets 4th & 5th period.
 - Class meets from 12:30pm to 4:30 or later.
- At the end of the 3rd semester students will take the state fire test in December. Skills and class final test must be completed prior to sitting for the state exam.
 Grade of 75 or better. Average of all 3 semesters.
 - Meet minimum hour requirement 468 hrs (TCFP)
 - Meet minimum physical requirements / Skills



Fire Academy Uniforms

- You are responsible for
 - Uniform Pants & Shirts x 2 \$80 total
 - Belt \$20
 - Boots \$70 \$250
 - TCC Tuition (1/3 of the tuition student, 2/3 paid by AISD)
- 4 T-Shirts will be issued to you by AISD
- 1 Zipper sweatshirt and patch will be issued to you by TCC. All patches are issued to you your senior year.
- If on free or reduced lunch program, tuition is covered by AISD.
- If issue with payment of uniform, contact AISD Fire Academy Coordinator.

Summer Physical training

- During the summer you will be responsible for completing a log of physical training.
- The first week of class you will be tested on the training you complete over the summer.
 - 50 pushups done properly
 - 100 Crunches
 - 150 lbs rescue dummy drag 100 feet

Fundraising
