Behavior Expectations of Spectators

It is the goal of the Arlington ISD Athletic Department to provide a positive and safe experience at all athletic events. To that end, we need your assistance and commitment as parents and spectators. Below is a list of expectations that will help promote an environment of sportsmanship.

- Always support your team and the efforts of all participants involved.
- Do not intimidate or ridicule a player, coach, or official before, during or after a contest.
- Always encourage student-athletes for their efforts during a game; never degrade a participant for their efforts. Athletics is a learning experience for students, and our student-athletes are working towards perfection.
- A ticket is a privilege to observe the contest.
- Always respect the integrity and judgment of officials. An official should never be degraded or ridiculed for a call they make.
- Show respect for all players, coaches, spectators and support groups.
- Be a positive role model at events through your own actions. Allow the coaches to teach and develop the student athletes, by refraining from coaching from the stands.

Spectators play a critical role in the student-athlete's experience of all athletic events. Above are the listed expectations for all fans that attend the events. If a situation arises where you, as a parent would like to meet with the coach, please contact coach via email or phone call. Please do not approach the coach during or after the practice or game. If a spectator cannot abide by these expectations, they may be warned, issued a letter of decorum, or removed from the event and/or restricted from attending future events.
