FLU SHOTS ON CAMPUS – NOVEMBER 6



Literacy In Action

Seguin is aggressively focused on increasing the literacy level of our students. You may ask, "why literacy?" We gave all of our 9th and 10th graders a Lexile test this year to test their reading level and 51% of our students scored at or below a 6th grade reading level. The research shows that there is a very strong relationship between literacy and a person's success, not only in school, but in life. Currently, we are focused on annotation of texts in different content areas. Annotation is the way students interact with the text to help them gather comprehension. It helps students determine what the details of the text demonstrate and what the writer wants us to take away from the reading. The process of annotation is the first step in ensuring our students are better readers, writers, speakers, and thinkers.

We have already seen increases in achievement on our district assessments and an increase in annotating skills. At this point, your children are probably tired of the focus on annotation...which must mean we're doing something right, lol! Please ask your students to demonstrate their annotation skills for you! It's a skill they will use for life!
