The Every Student Succeed Act (ESSA) requires each Title I school to hold an Annual Meeting for parents to...



What is Title I?





During the 2019-2020 school year

- 73.57% of students in AISD received Free/Reduced lunch
- 54 campuses received Title I funds
- 36,250* students were served with Title I funds

*MARCH 2, 2020

This year, 56 campuses will receive Title I funds.



Title I Academic Information Nights

All Title I campuses are required to provide information to parents on:

- Curriculum
- Academic Standards
- Proficiency levels required of students
- State Academic Standards
- State Assessments (STAAR, EOC)
- Strategies to support learning at home

Every Student Succeed Act Definition:

"The term parent <u>engagement</u> means the participation of parents in <u>regular</u>, <u>two-way</u> and <u>meaningful communication</u> involving student academic learning and other school activities."
