2013-2014 GENERAL FUND BUDGET

Cindy Powell, Chief Financial Officer, presented information regarding the 2013-2014 General Fund Budget. The DIDC was asked for their input for next year's budget. The budget will be adopted by the School Board in June. Mrs. Powell will present the first formal conversation with the School Board on Thursday, May Mrs. Powell reviewed budget highlights explaining the 16. process/development. In addition, she provided insight into the current legislative budget considerations - the current outlook is positive for AISD.

- 1. The Board consider an across the board pay increase that is significantly above 3%
