BOARD OF TRUSTEES NAMES ASSISTANT PRINCIPALS

ARLINGTON, Texas, October 3, 2019 – The AISD Board of Trustees today announces assistant principals for Sam Houston High School and Atherton Elementary.

Khristopher Latson will serve as an assistant principal at Sam Houston High School. Latson has been an English language learner/special education instructional specialist in the Dallas ISD since 2018. Prior to that, he was a special education teacher and coach at West Mesquite High School in the Mesquite ISD from 2007 to 2018. Latson has an associate degree from Eastfield College, a bachelor's degree from Texas A&M University-Commerce and a master's degree from Grand Canyon University.

Anna Crisostomo will serve as the assistant principal at Atherton Elementary. Crisostomo has been an instructional coach at Meacham and Rosemont middle schools in the Fort Worth ISD since 2018, and she was an eighth-grade science teacher and coach at Riverside Middle school in the FWISD from 2014 to 2018. Crisostomo taught eighth-grade science at Cordova Middle School in the Alhambra Elementary School District in Arizona from 2012 to 2014 and at Tartesso Elementary in the Saddle Mountain Unified School District in Arizona from 2011 to 2012. Crisostomo taught sixth-through-eighth grade ESL English at Durham Middle School in the Lewisville ISD from 2009 to 2011, and she was a seventh-grade science teacher and coach at Calhoun Middle School in the Denton ISD from 2007 to 2009. Crisostomo was also an ESL aide in the Lake Dallas ISD for part of a year in 2007 and a kindergarten-through-eighth grade PE and athletic coordinator at Carden Traditional Charter school from 2005 to 2006. Crisostomo served in the U.S. Army from 1993 to 1995. Crisostomo has a bachelor's from California State University and a master's from the University of Texas at Arlington.
