MINUTES

District-Level Instructional Decision Making Committee Tuesday, October 4, 2016 4:30-6:30 at the AISD Professional Development Center

Welcome and Introductions

Executive Director of Transformational Learning and DIDC Co-facilitator Dr. Rick Garcia opened the meeting at 4:35. New 2016-17 members were welcomed. Dr. Garcia reported that participation in the self-nomination and voting process has dramatically increased this cycle when compared with year's past. Over 800 staff members from the district participated in this year's vote.

DIDC Training

Co-facilitator Culley Franks lead the 2016-2017 Initiation Training to all members. This training reviewed the purpose of the DIDC as dictated by board policy. New members will be presented to the AISD School Board on Thursday, October 6.

Historical Update

Dr. Garcia reviewed the evolution of the DIDC from when it was under leadership with Dr. Marcelo Cavazos (at the time deputy Superintendent for AISD) to its current leadership under Chief Academic Officer Dr. Steven Wurtz.

Subcommittee Assignments

Dr. Wurtz gave the DIDC an overview of committees members could sign up for to represent DIDC membership. These committees include: Professional Learning Advisory Committee, DIP/PBMIS, Testing Calendar, and District of Innovation.

Dr. Wurtz also presented a summary of TEA's District of Innovation and AISD's efforts to apply for the designation. This distinction would allow the district to accelerate its work toward the AISD Strategic Plan. At the 10/6/16 meeting, the Board of Trustees will vote to approve the creation of a committee to create a plan to apply for the District of Innovation. If created, the DIDC will vote to approve the plan at the November 29th meeting.

Curriculum and Instruction Update

Director of Curriculum and Instruction Connie Wallace gave an overview of the work of the C & I department and its connections to the AISD Strategic Plan.

District Improvement Plan

Executive Director of Accountability and Research gave an overview of the purpose and creation of the 2016-17 District Improvement Plan. He explained the decision-making process to determine the 4 goals aligned with the AISD Strategic Plan.

Closure

Cabinet member Christi Peralta asked for members to check the membership sheet for accuracy and invited people to use the QR code on the agenda for feedback. The meeting was closed with parting remarks from Dr. Wurtz at 6:30.
