Tuesday, November 29, 2016 4:30-6:30 at the AISD Professional Development Center

Welcome and Introductions

Dr. Rick Garcia, Executive Director Transformational Learning, introduced and welcomed new community members, April Nohinek, Harry Flood, Christopher Smith, and Matthew Skaggs. New community members to the DIDC completed membership orientation with Dr. Garcia before today's meeting.

Dr. Steven Wurtz, Chief Academic Officer, clarified the District of Innovation Plan progress and timeline. A special DIDC meeting will be held on 1/10/16 for the DIDC to vote on the plan before it moves to the school board for approval. If the District of Innovation Plan is not ready, the DIDC special meeting will be canceled.

Active Learning Cycle

Dr. Wurtz orientated DIDC members on the AISD Active Learning Cycle. The Active Learning Cycle supports the AISD Strategic Plan through the development of "relevant, innovative, and rigorous learning experiences" for students. The district will begin implementation in June 2017 through a cohort model with full-district implementation by the 2021-2020 school year (a 5 year implementation plan).

DIP Quarterly Review

Dr. Kevin Barlow, Executive Director Research and Accountability, presented an overview of the 2016-2017 District Improvement Plan and the DIP Quarterly Review Process. He reviewed items that have been completed to date with a district goal of all strategies to be implemented by June 2017.

Testing Calendar Development

Dr. Barlow continued with an overview of the development of the 2017-2018 District Assessment calendar. The current calendar is slated to be presented to the board on April 21^s, 2017. Dr. Barlow will be in attendance at the 2/17/17 meeting to continue to update the DIDC members on the development of the testing calendar.

Professional Development Overview/PLAC

Shannon Terry, Director Professional Learning, highlighted the newly developed Professional Learning Department and gave the DIDC information about current initiatives which impact the district, campuses, and students. She introduced ESSA "Every Student Succeeds At", 6 criteria for quality professional learning. She previewed the timeline of work the PLAC (Professional Learning Action Committee) will engage in to create an AISD Professional Learning framework by June 2017
