TIER I INSTRUCTIONS:

- How are best practices identified and cross-pollinated across the district with respect to curriculum delivery?
- Who is re-writing the curricula? Are the teachers being consulted or asked for input?
- Curriculum Audit: Does this audit program consider teachers' years of experience, class being taught (Reg, PAP, AP)? In other words, how flexible is the program?
- Have you spoken to folks in Higher Ed. to align curriculum?
- All the plans to address issues are exciting! However, I know some teachers will be skeptical or negative; feeling like this is just another new "program" and more new demands on them. What is the strategy for getting each teacher on-board & excited?

BOND INITIATIVES:

- Dual Language/Fine Arts At the 5th/6th Grade level will the district be providing instruments to students once they pick their specialization?
- Elem. STEM Labs Will we consider designated staff to provide instruction in the STEM labs?

COLLEGE/CAREER READINESS:

- Be aware of a disparity between 'college ready' in H.S. and the percent who test into Dev. Ed. in College via Accuplacer. About 60% test into Dev. Ed.
- What level of Service Design (as outlined by the TEA) "In Compliance," "Recommended" or "Exemplary" is the District choosing for the design of **our** GT Program
- Plans to open a STEM Program on North Side of Arlington?
- STEM
 - Are credits earned able to be transferred to other colleges/universities
 - Does the student receive a transcript from UTA?
- GT Program
 - o Losing families to charters due to GT programs?
 - o Can we get competitive?
 - o Can we get designated staff to provide advance academics at the elementary level?

INCLUSIVE EDUCATION:

- Inclusion strategies sound good! To ensure success, what are the strategies for supporting the classroom teachers, who will now be absorbing more of the "high-maintenance" students, so that it does not take away from the other students and does not create frustration on the part of the teacher?
- Are we able to determine the impact that SHARS billing will have on Sped budget and staffing?
