Seven \$2,500 Chamber Scholarships are being offered to 2018-2019 graduating seniors of the Arlington Independent School District – one from each of the AISD's six traditional high schools and Arlington Collegiate High School at TCC-Southeast.

To be eligible for these scholarships, applicants are required to attend the University of Texas at Arlington or Tarrant County College by the academic year 2019-2020.

### Please read all the instructions as the application <u>must</u> include the following:

- Essay a typed 400 to 500 word essay on the following topic: Tell us why the career you have chosen will be in demand in the future.
- Academic and Personal Recommendations as defined on the Scholarship Application.
- High School Transcript.

NOTE: A PDF version of the **application**, available at <u>www.aisd.net/scholarships</u>, must be filled out prior to printing and included in the submission packet.

Judging criteria: The essay will be evaluated based upon content, originality, overall impression, and proper grammatical and punctuation usage.

**Selection Criteria:** Members of the Greater Arlington Chamber of Commerce Partners in Education Committee and community business leaders will evaluate all applications received. The top two applicants from each school will be interviewed by a panel of the Greater Arlington Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors and Partners in Education Committee members for the final decision.
