Background:

On January 17, 2019, the Arlington ISD Board of Trustees approved an Order of Election calling a general election to fill places four and five on the Board of Trustees of the Arlington Independent School District.

In accordance with Section 2.053(a) of the Texas Election Code, the AISD Board may cancel the election if the candidates have been certified as unopposed. The deadline for candidates to file to be on the ballot was February 15, 2019, and the deadline for a candidate to be declared a write-in candidate was February 19, 2019. Background: The District is constructing an addition at the Jones Fine Arts & Dual Language Academy. Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC requires an easement and right-of-way for underground electric supply and communications lines, consisting of a variable number of wires and cables, surface mounted equipment, conduits, manholes, vaults, transformers, switches, switchgears, auto-transformers, protection, sectionalizing devices and all necessary or desirable appurtenances over, under, across and upon the subject property.

The easement gives Oncor access to construct, maintain, operate, repair, remove, replace, reconstruct, abandon in place, and to change the size and capacity of the facilities required to provide electric service to the Jones Fine Arts & Dual Language Academy and the right to relocate said facilities in the same relative direction of said facilities or same relative position to any adjacent road if and as such road is widened in the future. It also extends Oncor the right to lease wire space along the facilities and the right to restrict excavation or construction within the easement if Oncor determines that such work may endanger or interfere with their infrastructure. The easement will encompass 4,154 square feet (or 0.095 acres).

That **ARLINGTON INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT**, hereinafter called "Grantor," whether one or more, for and in consideration of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other valuable consideration to Grantor in hand paid by **Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC**, **a Delaware limited liability company**, 1616 Woodall Rodgers Freeway, Dallas, Texas 75202-1234, hereinafter referred to as "Grantee", has granted, sold and conveyed and by these presents does grant, sell and convey unto said Grantee, its successors and assigns, an easement and right-of-way for underground electric supply and communications lines, consisting of a variable number of wires and cables, surface mounted equipment, conduits, manholes, vaults, transformers, switches, switchgears, auto-transformers, protection, sectionalizing devices and all necessary or desirable appurtenances over, under, across and upon Grantor's land described as follows:

SEE EXHIBIT "A" (ATTACHED)

Grantor recognizes that the general course of said lines, or the metes and bounds as above described, is based on preliminary surveys only, and Grantor hereby agrees that the easement and right-of-way and its general dimensions hereby granted shall apply to the actual location of said lines when constructed.

Together with the right of ingress and egress along and upon said easement and right-of-way and over and across Grantor's adjoining properties for the purpose of and with the right to construct, maintain, operate, repair, remove, replace, reconstruct, abandon in place, and to change the size and capacity of said facilities; the right to relocate said facilities in the same relative direction of said facilities; the right to relocate said facilities in the same relative position to any adjacent road if and as such road is widened in the future: the right to lease wire space for the purpose of permitting others to string or lay wire or cable along said facilities; the right to prevent excavation within the easement area; the right to prevent construction of, within the easement area, any and all buildings, structures or other obstructions which, in the sole judgment of Grantee, may endanger or interfere with the efficiency, safety, and/or convenient operation of said facilities and their appurtenances and the right to trim or remove trees or shrubbery within, but not limited to, said easement area, including by use of herbicides or other similar chemicals approved by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, to the extent in the sole judgment of Grantee, as may be necessary to prevent possible interference with the operation of said facilities or to remove possible hazard thereto. Grantor shall not make changes in grade, elevation or contour of the land or impound water within the easement area as described above without prior written consent of Grantee.

Grantor reserves the right to use the land within the above described easement area for purposes not inconsistent with Grantee's use of such property, provided such use shall not, in the sole judgment of Grantee, interfere with the exercise by Grantee of the rights hereby granted.



Purpose:

To update the Board on long-range financial planning for capital needs and the general operating budget

Background:

Thoughtful long-range planning is essential to ensure the District remains fiscally sound and uses resources effectively to accomplish the strategic plan goal that "100% of AISD students will graduate exceptionally prepared for college, career and citizenship." Consideration must be given to strategic plan strategies, the state school finance system, capital needs and stakeholder priorities. Resources, including staffing, must be aligned to curriculum outcomes and instructional priorities.

Two Board-appointed committees – the 2019 Capital Needs Steering Committee and the Financial Futures Committee - are actively studying the District's general operating budget and capital needs and will present recommendations to the Board of Trustees in the coming months for prioritized needs to support the District's strategic plan. Community meetings and surveys have been conducted to gather input to inform the work of the two committees. The Board will determine appropriate actions to address recommendations presented by the two committees, including possibly calling a tax ratification election and/or a bond election.

The Administration will provide an update of the planning work currently underway for capital needs and the general operating budget, including survey results informing the work and considerations for prekindergarten.
