
Should any final action, final decision or final vote be required in the opinion of the Board with regard to any matter considered in such closed meeting, then such final action, final decision or final vote shall be at either:


Purpose: To consider adoption of a resolution for the recall of Mike O'Donnell, President of the Board of Directors of the Tarrant Appraisal District

Background: Each appraisal district is governed by a board of directors comprised of five directors elected by the taxing units that participate in the appraisal district. Members of the board of directors serve two-year terms beginning on January 1 of even-numbered years.

On November 21, 2019, the AISD Board of Trustees voted to cast all of AISD's 450 votes for Mike O'Donnell in the election of TAD Board of Directors for the two-year term beginning January 1, 2020. Mr. O'Donnell is an AISD resident and former school trustee. He has served as a director on the TAD Board of Directors since 2014.

Mr. O'Donnell notified the District that he can no longer serve on the TAD Board of Directors due to increased time demands of his personal job. He asked that he be recalled from the TAD Board of Directors "to allow for the selection of another individual who can devote the necessary time and energy to which all parties involved are entitled."

Recommendation: The Administration recommends that the Board of Trustees approve a resolution that all of the votes allocated to AISD be cast for the recall of Mr. Mike O'Donnell, President of the Tarrant Appraisal District Board of Directors.



SUBJECT: Competitive Sealed Proposal for the 2019 Bond Program, Phase 1, Bid Package 4, Enterprise Centre Addition and Renovations Project

The District approved addition and renovations for the Enterprise Centre as a part of the 2019 Bond program. Additionally, the Board of Trustees approved Corgan Architects (Corgan) as the design professional and approved Competitive Sealed Proposal (CSP) as the method of construction procurement for the project.

The project architect, Corgan, completed the construction documents and the District requested proposals. Notification of the request for CSP was sent to local contractors, area chambers of commerce and contractors on a list supplied by the DFW Minority Business Council. Notice of the request for CSP was also advertised in accordance with state law.

Proposals were received from twenty-one general contractors:

Competitive Sealed Proposals received from the proposers were evaluated based criteria published in the CSP document:

Price	35%
Qualifications	40%
HUB Participation	10%
Interview	15%

An evaluation committee consisting of the Chief Financial Officer, Executive Director of Plant Services, Director of Facility Planning and Construction, the Senior Project Manager, the Project Manager, and the Design Architect completed evaluations. Key Construction, Inc., (Key) ranked highest amongst all proposers at 85.51 points. District staff worked with Key to ensure that the intended project scope is being addressed, identify opportunities to reduce the proposed cost and verify the project budget.

The total project budget for the Enterprise Center is \$11,715,000. This total includes 2019 Bond Program funds in the amount of \$9,591,520 and 2014 Bond Program funds in the amount of \$2,802,589.

Key offered a competitive sealed proposal amount of \$11,995,000 for the project. Administration recommends accepting add Alternate #3, in the amount of \$19,000 to provide a multi-step capacitor bank for energy system power factor correction and add Alternate #4A, in the amount of \$5,200 for tree pruning to improve site aesthetics and meet City of Arlington code review requests. Additionally, administration recommends accepting certain value engineering (VE) options to reduce the proposed project cost by \$88,532. The final contract amount including add alternates and VE is \$11,930,668.

The proposed construction contract exceeds the construction budget; however, the sum of fees and proposed construction contract is \$463,441 less than the overall project budget.

Based on this evaluation, the committee recommends accepting the Competitive Sealed Proposal, add Alternates #3 and #4A, and the recommended Value Engineering options as submitted by Key totaling \$11,930,668.

The architect's letter of recommendation for construction contract award for addition and renovations for the Enterprise Centre is attached.

Pending approval of the CSP, work on this project will begin in the spring of 2020 with final completion expected in the spring of 2021.

Dear Mr. Horn:

On Thursday, June 18, 2020 the Arlington Independent School District received twenty-one competitive sealed proposals for the Enterprise Centre Renovation Project located at 690 East Lamar Boulevard in Arlington, Texas.

The proposals consisted of a base proposal and five alternates. All proposals received were from qualified general contractors and included staff qualifications and references as required by the proposal documents. All proposals were reviewed with the contractor's references being contacted and ranked based on the published evaluation criteria as specified in the request for proposals. The top five ranked proposers were invited to participate in an interview to conclude the evaluation phase.

After complete and careful review of the criteria including total submitted contract price, Corgan and the Arlington ISD evaluation committee has ranked Key Construction as the top ranked proposer.

We recommend awarding a contract for the construction of the Enterprise Centre Renovations Project to Key Construction with the acceptance and inclusion of Alternates #3 and #4A, Value Engineer options VE5, VE8, VE9 and VE12, the amount of \$339,000.00 for Owner's Project Contingency and the amount of \$10,000.00 for Curb, Parking Lot and Fire Lane Striping Allowance for the total construction contract amount of \$11,930,668.00.

We trust this recommendation meets with your approval and look forward to the successful completion of this project.

Subject:	Staff Development Waiver for the 2020-2021 School Year	

Purpose:

The administration is seeking approval to apply for the Staff Development - General Waiver allowable under the provision of Texas Education Code (TEC) §7.056.

Background:

This waiver allows the district and charter schools to train staff on various educational strategies designed to improve student performance in lieu of student instruction during the school year.


The *Staff Development Minutes Waiver* provides for a maximum of 2,100 total waiver minutes to use for professional development for districts and charter schools that provide operational and instructional minutes.

Each district and open-enrollment charter school may choose how to apply their approved *Staff Development Minutes Waiver*. For instance, schools may choose to offer early release, late start, all day staff development, or a combination. However, the total waiver minutes for staff development shall not exceed 2,100 minutes per year (5 days).

The District is seeking four (4) staff development days in lieu of student instruction in accordance with what the approved Arlington ISO 2020-2021 District Calendar will allow.

Recommendation:

The recommendation is that the Board approve the request to apply for the Staff Development - General Waiver to enable the district to provide two (2) staff development days in lieu of student instruction for the 2020-2021 school year.
