


Arlington ISD Credit by Exam (CBE) For Grade Level Acceleration and Course Credit Grades K-12

CREDIT BY EXAM (CBE) FOR GRADE LEVEL ACCELERATION AND COURSE CREDIT GRADES K-12

OVERVIEW

Arlington ISD offers exams for acceleration for each primary school grade level (with no prior instruction) and for high school course credit (with no prior instruction and with prior instruction) for students enrolled in AISD. The exams are designed to assess the student's mastery of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) for a grade level or course.

Arlington ISD uses state-approved criterion-referenced exams developed by The University of Texas at Austin. In the case of language courses for which a CBE is not available from The University of Texas at Austin, an attempt will be made to secure an exam that meets all of the requirements from another provider. For example, an AVANT **STA**ndards-based **M**easurement of **P**roficiency (STAMP) Monolingual exam will be offered to native speakers that meet the eligibility. Currently, this exam is available in Arabic and Spanish. CBEs, with the exception of those for Languages Other Than English (LOTE) academic subjects, are only available in English. Online exams will be utilized for grades 3-12 unless the exam is only available in a paper format. Paper exams will be utilized for students in grades K-2.

Course study guides are available on The University of Texas at Austin website (https://highschool.utexas.edu/cbe_study_guides). Students are encouraged to review the study guides prior to testing. Study guides for Communication Applications, English, Art, and PE are essential as these exams have specific requirements.

CBE FOR GRADE LEVEL ACCELERATION & HIGH SCHOOL COURSE CREDIT WITH NO PRIOR INSTRUCTION

The content of each CBE for grade level acceleration or high school course credit with no prior instruction is based on a grade level or course that the student has not taken. Therefore, a high-achieving student in one grade level or subject area may lack the content knowledge to pass a CBE. Student performance and records should indicate a high probability of success for any student wanting to take a CBE.

CBE for Grade Level Acceleration - Grades K-8 (With No Prior Instruction)

A student who wishes to accelerate a grade level (K-8) in which he or she has had **no prior instruction** may request grade level acceleration through CBE. The student must meet **each** one of the following requirements:

- The student is at least five years old by September 1;
- The student earns a minimum of 80% on **each** of the four content area, district-approved criterion-referenced exams (language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies);
- A school district representative recommends that the student be accelerated;
- The student's parent or guardian gives written approval for the acceleration.

Arlington ISD's Department of Research and Accountability determines the appropriate exams to be administered for each student wishing to accelerate a grade level (K-8).

A student may not attempt to accelerate a particular grade by examination more than once.

Placement in a new grade will occur as outlined in the AISD 2025-2026 Credit by Exam Schedule for Grades K-12 included in this document.

CBE for Course Credit in Grades 6-12 (With No Prior Instruction)

A student in grades 6-12 who wishes to earn credit for a high school course or courses in which he or she has had **no prior instruction** may request course acceleration through CBE.

A student enrolled in AISD must take the CBE for course credit for acceleration prior to the beginning of the school year in which the student would ordinarily be required to enroll in that course in accordance with the school district's prescribed course sequence. Otherwise, the student must satisfactorily complete the course to receive credit. A student who enrolls in the district after the beginning of the school year in which the student would ordinarily be required to enroll in that course in accordance with the district's prescribed course sequence may be administered a CBE for course acceleration at any point during the school year.

- The student will be given credit for an academic subject in which he or she has had no prior instruction if the student scores a minimum of 80% on the applicable district-approved criterion-referenced subject area exam.
- The student may take a specific subject area CBE for course acceleration only once during each window.
- A student may not attempt to earn credit by examination for a specific high school course more than two times.
- A CBE for course acceleration may not be taken a second time if a passing score was achieved on the first attempt.

AVANT (STAMP) Monolingual eligibility also includes the following:

- Student has attended U.S. schools less than 3 years.
- Student does **not** have two foreign language credits on his/her transcript.
- Student has **not** taken an AVANT Spanish language placement test.

If a student earns credit for an exam on which the student scored 80% or higher for an academic subject in which he or she has had no prior instruction, the student's CBE score must be recorded on the student's transcript. The score shall not be included in the calculation of class rank or counted towards the grade point average (GPA). The student is not required to take an applicable end-of-course exam for the course.

Advanced Placement (AP) Exam or College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) for Course Credit in Grades 6-12 (With No Prior Instruction)

Students in grades 6-12 can also receive credit without prior instruction by scoring a three on an advanced placement (AP) exam or a scaled score of 50 or higher on exams administered through the College-Level Examination Program (CLEP). The student's counselor can provide additional information regarding course credit earned through an AP exam or CLEP.

CBE FOR COURSE CREDIT RECOVERY WITH PRIOR INSTRUCTION

CBE for Course Credit Recovery in Grades 6-12 (With Prior Instruction)

A student in grades 6-12 who wishes to earn credit for a high school course or courses in which he or she had **prior instruction** and did not receive credit may request course credit recovery through CBE.

- Prior instruction is defined as:
 - A course taken for which credit was not received due to a failing grade or excessive absences;
 - A course taken from a non-accredited school;
 - A course taken from an equivalent agency from another state; or
 - A course taken from an accredited association recognized by the Commissioner of Education

A student will be given credit for a course in which he or she has had **prior instruction** if the student scores a minimum of 70% on the applicable district-approved criterion-referenced subject area exam.

A student may take a specific subject area CBE for course credit recovery only once during each window.

A student may not attempt to earn credit by examination for a specific high school course more than two times.

A CBE for course credit recovery may not be taken a second time if a passing score was achieved on the first attempt.

If a student earns credit for an exam on which the student scored 70% or higher for an academic subject in which he or she has had prior instruction, the student's CBE score must be recorded on the student's transcript. The score shall not be included in the calculation of class rank or counted towards the grade point average (GPA). CBE for credit recovery shall not be used to gain eligibility for participation in extracurricular activities.

SCHEDULING AND COST FOR CBE

CBE for grade level acceleration or course credit is offered during four windows throughout the year. CBEs are administered on the student's campus during the window by a certified educator. CBEs for grade level acceleration or course credit should be scheduled in consultation with the student's counselor and in accordance with the AISD 2025-2026 Credit by Exam Schedule for Grades K-12 and all CBE guidelines. The application packet for CBEs can be obtained from the student's counselor or from the Arlington ISD website.

High school campuses will order, administer, and return CBEs for their eligible students according to the exam provider's guidelines. Arlington ISD's Department of Research and Accountability will order CBEs for eligible students in grades K-8 who register by the appropriate deadline.

CBEs are provided at no cost to the student. While there is no charge to the student to take a CBE, there is a charge to the district for the exam. If the student does not take an exam for which he/she is registered, the district will not assume the cost for the student to register again for the same exam. In this case, the parent/guardian would be required to order and pay for the exam(s) from the approved vendor. Therefore, schedules should be carefully considered prior to registration to ensure the student can be available each day of the testing window.
