In 2014, voters approved a bond package. Included in the package was a district-wide career and technical education center and a district-wide agricultural science facility with new opportunities and programs for students. Over thirty programs of study are available at the Dan Dipert Career and Technical Center (CTC) with most courses being junior or senior level.

AGRICULTURAL SCIENCE CENTER (ASC)
