- 1) Completed Application Form with proper signatures
- 2) A statement of not more than 300 words outlining the applicant's educational and vocational aims, any special circumstances the student might deem important, and an indication of how this aid would benefit the applicant
- 3) A letter of recommendation from each of the following:
 - a. Teacher
 - b. An adult of your choice who is NOT a family member
- 4) A current official High School Transcript
- 5) Copy of a photograph of the applicant

Criteria for application are as follows:

- 1) You MUST hold U.S. citizenship
- 2) You may not be related to an Altrusa member
- 3) You must plan to attend a college within the U.S.A. and enroll by March of the following year.

The winner will be notified by letter.

The winner and his/her family will be invited to attend an Altrusa meeting on Tuesday, June 11, 2024, to recognize the scholarship recipient.
