Retirement - FAQ





Your retirement date is determined by the Teacher Retirement System (TRS), which offers several types of retirement: Normal Age, Early Age, Disability, and provisions for Grandfathered Members. Your eligibility for one of these retirement options, along with your years of service, will determine when you can retire.

How long does my insurance continue with AISD after I retire?

Your medical and supplemental benefits will end on the date of your final paycheck.



What happens to my state, local and vacation time?

Per our company policy, any accrued state, local, and vacation time will be forfeited upon your separation from employment.

How do I obtain my W-2 after retirement?

You will receive instructions in your retirement email or on the AISD Retirement Page under Employee Service Center.



How much will my annuity be?

Your retirement annuity payments will be determined by TRS. Upon the employee's request TRS will prepare an estimate of benefits.



What about the Retirement Certification (TRS-7) when will that be sent? The Payroll Department will submit your Retirement Certification to TRS after you have

received your final paycheck. Please reach out to Payroll for any questions.



Can I work/volunteer after retirement (EAR)? TRS has limitations with how many days and hours an employee will be eligible to work. Please reach out to TRS for further details.

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
