

# Retirement – FAQ

## When can I retire?

Your retirement date is determined by the Teacher Retirement System (TRS), which offers several types of retirement: Normal Age, Early Age, Disability, and provisions for Grandfathered Members. Your eligibility for one of these retirement options, along with your years of service, will determine when you can retire.

## How long does my insurance continue with AISD after I retire?

Your medical and supplemental benefits will end on the date of your final paycheck.

## What happens to my state, local and vacation time?

Per our company policy, any accrued state, local, and vacation time will be forfeited upon your separation from employment.

## My total years of service with TRS are not accurately reflecting AISD service record. What do I do?

## How do I obtain my W-2 after retirement?

You will receive instructions in your retirement email or on the AISD Retirement Page under Employee Service Center.

## How much will my annuity be?

Your retirement annuity payments will be determined by TRS. Upon the employee's request TRS will prepare an estimate of benefits.

## What about the Retirement Certification (TRS-7) when will that be sent?

The Payroll Department will submit your Retirement Certification to TRS after you have received your final paycheck. Please reach out to Payroll for any questions.

## Can I work/volunteer after retirement (EAR)?

TRS has limitations with how many days and hours an employee will be eligible to work. Please reach out to TRS for further details.
