- Proof of Address: rental lease or current utility bill from the residence - a phone bill or driver's license is not proof of address- or a residency affidavit if the parent or guardian is living with a friend or family member.
- Last Report Card
- Social Security Card
- Birth Certificate

Returning students must have documentation (email confirmation, submission confirmation) that shows they have completed their pre- registration online before coming on the designated schedule card pick- up days (see below).

IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION 9-12th -Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis- DPT– Tdap -Td : at least 3

doses with one after age 4 and one less than 10 years ago

Polio: 3 doses,with one since age 4

MMR: 2 doses after the 1st birthday at least 28 days apart

Hepatitis B: 3 doses over no less than a 4- month period

Hepatitis A: 2 doses for grades 9-10

Varicella: 2 doses after age 1 OR history of chicken pox illness

Meningococcal 1 dose on or after 10th birthday

Meningococcal applies to all students

Test of immunity is acceptable in lieu of vaccine for measles,mumps, rubella, hepatitis B or varicella.
