- Proof of Current Immunization-must be up to date
- Proof of Address: rental lease or current utility bill from the residence (a phone bill or driver's license is not proof of address) or a residency affidavit if the parent or guardian is living with a friend or family member.
- Last Report Card
- Social Security Card
- Birth Certificate

Current AISD Students

Returning students must have documentation (email confirmation, submission confirmation) that shows they have completed their pre- registration online before attending the designated schedule card pick- up days below.

All students need Proof of Address: rental lease or current utility bill from the residence - a phone bill or driver's license is not proof of address - or a residency affidavit if the parent or guardian is living with a friend or family member.

IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION 7th & 8th grade

Diphtheria Tetanus/Pertussis: At least 3 doses, with one since age 4
Tdap/TD booster: **7th grade:** 1 dose if it has been 5 years since last dose of DTP/Tdap/TD booster
Tdap/TD booster: **8th grade:** 1 dose within last 10 years
Polio: 3 doses, with one since age 4
MMR: 2 doses, both after age 1
Hepatitis B: 3 doses over no less than a 4-month period
Varicella: 2 doses OR history of chicken pox, all after age 1
Meningococcal: 1 dose: on or after 10th birthday
Hepatitis A: 2 doses, both after age 1
