### Arlington ISD Pre-K Scholarship 2021- 2022 Program Key Notes

- To be eligible for a prekindergarten scholarship, a child must be at least four years of age on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> of the current school year.
- Families who do not qualify for free Pre-K services and who meet the expanded income guidelines for the scholarship will be considered.
- Priority is for a child who resides within Arlington ISD school attendance zones (parent/guardian must provide proof of address: current gas, water or electricity bill or the lease/mortgage agreement in the name of the parent/guardian).
- Proof of Income--Last 30 days for all adults living in the household.
- A 2021-2022 Arlington ISD Pre-K registration form must be submitted prior applying for a Pre-K scholarship.
- The Early Childhood Department will review all Pre-K scholarships forms.
  - AISD Pre- K 4 scholarship students will be registered at their home campus or at the closest school if seats are not available or if the enrollment of eligible Pre-K students may be compromised.
  - The submission of a Pre- K 4 scholarship application does not guarantee eligibility.
