I am aware of the fact that if the student(s) cease to reside at the above address, the student(s) will be subject to immediate withdrawal from the Arlington Independent School District. I am also aware that they will be monitored throughout the school year to ensure that they remain at the above address.

If the student(s) should cease to reside at the above address and continue to attend school in the Arlington Independent School District, I am aware that I am subject to be prosecuted under the full extent of the law.

Falsification of Information

The penalties under 37.10 (a penal code dealing with falsifying government records) are as follows:

Any person who knowingly falsifies information on a form required for enrollment of a student in a school district commits an offense under Section 37.10 of the Penal Code, which offense is a Class A misdemeanor unless the person's intent is to defraud or harm another, in which event the offense is a felony of the third degree. Further, such person is liable to the district if the student is not eligible for enrollment in the district but is enrolled on the basis of the false information. The person is liable, for the period during which the ineligible student is enrolled, for the greater of: (1) maximum tuition fee the district may charge under 25.038, Texas Education Code; or (2) the amount the district has budgeted for each student as maintenance and operation expenses. A Class A misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$2,000.00, a confinement in a jail for a term not to exceed one year, or both such fine and imprisonment. A third degree felony is punishable by a prison sentence for a term of not more than ten years or less than two years, and additionally, by a fine not to exceed \$5,000.00.

I also attest that the above named student(s) presence in the district is not for the primary purpose of participation in extracurricular activities.
