Your eligible children have the right to:

- Receive a free, appropriate public education.
- Servention of the server of th
- Enroll in school and attend classes while the school gathers important documents.
- Enroll in the local school or continue attending their school of origin if preferred.
- Receive transportation to and from school, if requested.
- Receive educational services comparable to those provided to other children, according to your childrens' needs.
